Field:The final field will comprise the top four from the Central Queensland QualifyingFinal and the top four from the North Queensland Qualifying Final.

Reserves:The reserves will comprise fifth place in the Central Queensland Qualifying Final andfifth place in the North Queensland Qualifying Final.

In the event of a scratching, reserves will be allocated in accordance with GAR 85 (11) whereby the priority order will be determined as follows:

- 1. A North Queensland qualifier scratching will be replaced by the North Queensland reserve.
- 2. A Central Queensland qualifier scratching will be replaced by the Central Queensland reserve.
- 3. In the event of more than one scratching, both reserves will be allocated a starting box.

Eligibility Conditions

A greyhound is eligible to be nominated for a Country Cup Qualifier if it has been domiciled in the country region for a minimum of 76 days from 12/8/22 to 9/1/23.

A greyhound is deemed to be domiciled at a particular address as per the date on the kennel notification form (or equivalent evidence produced) as processed by QRIC.

The country region includes Gympie (post code 4570) and anywhere further north. A greyhound is only eligible to contest either the Central Queensland Qualifier or the North Queensland Qualifier, not both.
