

## PROJECT UPDATE

Construction on The Q continues to make steady progress with Racing Minister Tim Mander and Director General Andrew Hopper touring the venue earlier this month.

During the visit, the Racing Minister was taken behind-the-scenes of the progress being made at The Q, including the construction of the grandstand building and the progress to each of the tracks.

Key updates include:

## **GRANDSTAND:**

- Kitchen equipment is being finalised in the commercial kitchen for the dining bistro on level 1.
- Grandstand seating works have commenced. This includes the spectator seating areas that overlooks the two-turn and one-Turn/straight tracks.
- Final plumbing fit-offs are underway across all three levels.
- All vinyl flooring completed to racing operation areas at ground level. This includes the kennel areas, swab bays and vet room.

## · Glazing completed to ground level and nearing completion to level 1.

**December Project Update** 

- Integrity area walkway roof sheeting is nearing completion.
- Office walls and ceiling works underway in the main office space at ground level.
- · Office joinery installation underway.

## TRACKS:

- The 350m Q Straight track sand installation is underway and nearing completion. This includes the installation of the protective geofabric layer, final track drainage infrastructure and sand topping layer.
- The Q1 final subgrade inspection has been finalised and has been approved by RQ. Sand stockpiling and spreading will commence in the final week of January.
- Works are progressing well to new long-distance start on the Q1. All other starts including those on The Q Straight and Q2 are nearing completion.
- Q1 fencing, gates and padding installation has been completed.
- With the exception of The Q2 starting boxes, all racing infrastructure has been installed and ready for commissioning.
- Track irrigation installation and commissioning on The Q Straight is now complete.
